

## COMMUNISM IN HUNGARY – AN OVERVIEW 3 NIGHTS IN BUDAPEST



Situated just a short flight from London, this small landlocked country was pivotal in the collapse of the Iron Curtain in Eastern Europe.

This 4 day trip offers a unique opportunity to learn about the history of Communism in Hungary.

You will be accompanied in Budapest by an expert teacher over 2 full days taking in the relevant historic sites relating to the Communist era.

### **Day 1**

Depart on scheduled flights to Budapest. You will be met on arrival and transferred to your hotel.  
PM - City tour of Budapest first taking in the sights of Pest before crossing the Margherita Bridge to Buda.

### **Day 2**

AM : 2 hour-long talk by an expert teacher about Communism in Hungary and Eastern Europe, the national revolution in 1956, and an introduction to the following day's programme.  
PM : Visit to the House of Terror Museum.

### **Day 3**

AM: Visit to Memento Park accompanied by an expert teacher.  
Lunch at the Lázár Equestrian Park with live gypsy music and horse show displays.

PM : Visit to the Secret Rock Hospital, the former top secret Military Hospital and Nuclear Bunker – under the codename of LOSK 0101/1 – beneath Buda Castle and now open to the public.

### **Day 4**

After breakfast transfer to Budapest Airport for your flight back to the UK.

**Prices start from £695** per person travelling during February half-term low season (based on a minimum of group size of 15 persons) – *1 free leader place per 10 paying pupils.*
