Extension to Galapagos

4 days / 3 nights at the Finch Bay Hotel

Daily Itinerary

Day 7 - Galapagos, Sunday

Escorted transfer between Hotel in Guayaquil and airport.

Baggage handling of two pieces of luggage per person at airport and at hotel is included.

Arrival to Galápagos by plane, to the airport at Baltra Island, and then cross the Itabaca Channel, which separates it from Santa Cruz Island. On the other side, a bus will take guests to the highlands of Santa Cruz Island to visit the Giant Tortoises Reserve in their natural habitat, a unique experience! A stop is made at the Twin Pit Craters, great depressions of volcanic material, formed by a long process of slow sinking of the ground, where exceptional Scalesia trees, ferns, mosses and orchids can be seen in the surroundings. Box lunch is provided and then on to the Finch Bay Eco Hotel to enjoy its multiple attractions: pool, the white coral beach in front of the hotel or rest in your hammock. In the evening, dinner includes the flavors of local and international gastronomy, one more attraction of the Finch Bay Eco Hotel.



Day 8 - Galapagos, Monday

Day excursions by boat to nearby Islands

Before departure, a bountiful buffet breakfast is served, including a variety of fruit, cereals, eggs, milk, yoghurt, fresh fruit juices, breads and more. For the excursions, please take solar protection,

cap or hat, bathing suit, long-sleeved shirt, snorkeling gear, cameras and appropriate shoes for wet landing and hikes on lava terrain (sneakers or similar) with thick soles. Lunch is served on board.

Upon return, there will be time to relax in the hotel's surroundings before dinner.

NORTH SEYMOUR ISLAND Boat Excursion

A stroll on flat terrain allows the observation of Palo Santo trees and colonies of blue-footed boobies, swallow-tailed gulls and magnificent frigate birds. Towards the other side of the island, the ocean crashes against the rocks and sea lions surf in the waves.



Day 9 - Galapagos, Tuesday

PLAZA ISLAND

This small island is full of fascinating wildlife, at sea side and along the cliffs: sea lions, land iguanas, swallow-tailed gulls, Opuntia cacti and vegetation that changes colors with the seasons.

Day 10 - Galapagos, Wednesday

Leave the hotel early in the morning for a visit to the Charles Darwin Research Station, home to famous "Lonesome George" and many other giant tortoises. Then, overland transfer to the airport in Baltra to take the 12.15 flight back to Guayaquil. Depart Guayaquil at 17.40 on Iberia flight IB6464, arrive Madrid at 13.45 hours the next day.



Day 11 – Madrid – London, Thursday

15.15 hours- Depart Madrid on flight IB3172 arriving Heathrow Terminal 2 at 16.35 hours.

Important Notes:

- **Daily excursions by boat are subject to change** due to climatic or oceanic conditions, regulations of the Galápagos National Park and always taking in consideration our guest's safety and well-being.
